PUBLIC AWARENESS LECTURE SERIES

As part of the Public Awareness Lecture Series (PALS) initiative by Subharti Dental College and Hospital, the Department of Periodontology and Implantology organized an Oral Health Awareness Camp on 28th July 2025 in the village of Jatpura, located near Meerut, Uttar Pradesh.
