

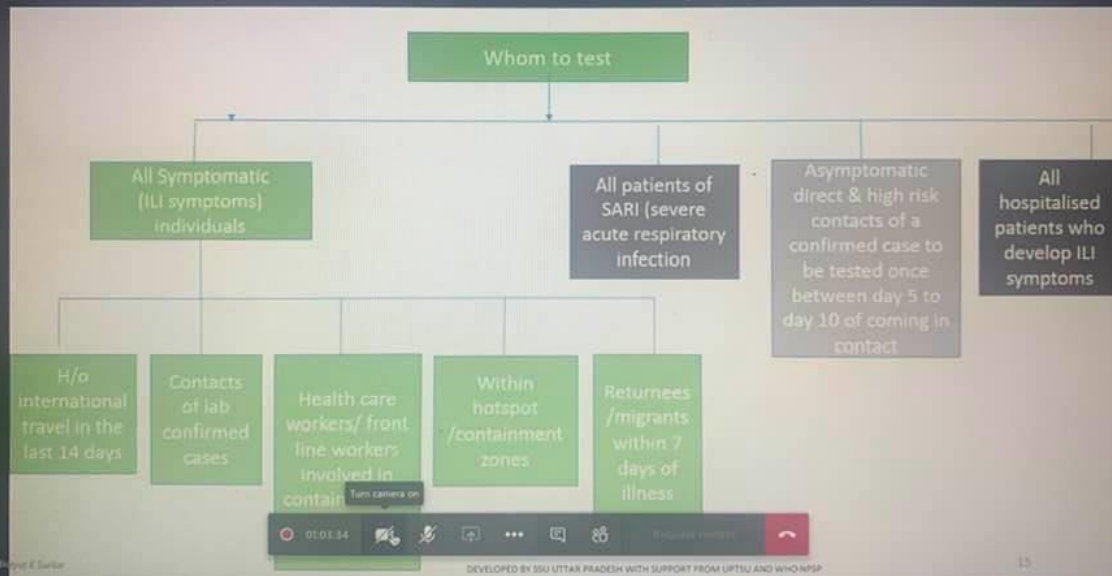

Tobacco use: the most preventable cause of premature mortality

– **Tobacco use** causes 8 million or 80 lakh deaths each year globally due to:

- ❖ **Cardiovascular diseases:** carbon monoxide (CO); nitrogen oxide
- ❖ **Respiratory diseases:** hydrogen cyanide
- ❖ **Cancers:** tobacco specific nitrosamines; benzopyrene; aldehydes; benzene; toluene

In India, smoking and smokeless tobacco use causes almost 1 million or 10 lakh deaths each year.

- ❖ Highest number of **oral cancer cases** in the world
 - ✓ Pre-cancerous: Leukoplakia; Erythroplakia (SMF)

Tobacco smoke and tar are responsible for the health effects & nicotine
