


Tobacco use: the most preventable cause of premature mortality

- Tobacco use causes 8 million or 80 lakh deaths each year globally due to:
- · Cardiovascular diseases: carbon monoxide (CO);nitrogen oxide
- · Respiratory diseases: hydrogen cyanide
- Cancers: tobacco specific nitrosamines; benzopyrene; aldehydes; benzene; toluene

In India, smoking and smokeless tobacco use causes almost 1 million or 10 lakh deaths each year.
